- i) Each paper should ideally be of 120 printed pages approximately (one 'Unit' comprising some 20, (±5 pages) and is to be written in lucid English). The content of text-materials being strictly of Post Graduate standard;
- ii) "Select Readings" for each unit should ordinarily be confined to 5 (five) texts and be mentioned at the end of each unit indicating name of author, the year of publications, place of publications, etc.
- iii) Each unit of the paper should contain some sample questions of 3 (three) types viz. long answer type, short answer type and objective type;
- iv) Examples should be given wherever necessary, for the purpose of clarity;
- v) Brief reference to issues related to new additions to knowledge, generally not found in conventional text-books, may be made within the space available. Please feel free to make minor adjustments, if necessary;
- vi) Manuscripts (in typescripts or handwritten) may be prepared on one side of the paper, in double-space, keeping adequate margin on both sides.
- vii) Diagrams, Charts etc. should be separately clipped on to the relevant page of the manuscripts.
- viii) The University will have the copy rights after its publication.

We hopefully expect that the assigned text-materials, prepared on the above lines, would reach the University within 06 weeks of receiving the assignment at the latest, so that we can stick to our work-programme. Should you, however, feel at any stage that you might need an extension of
