


# Netaji Subhas Open University School of Social Sciences PCP Feedback Form (2018-19)






# Do you attend PCP Classes Regularly?

The result shows that the learners present in the class room regularly attend the PCPs and take the advantage of peer learning.




# Are PCP's taken by teacher regularly?

The majority of the learners present expressed that the PCP organized by the university is excellent.




### Services available at your Study Centre:
