CALL FOR PAPERS

Academicians, professionals, research scholars, students, and others are invited to submit their abstract along with keywords of research works within stipulated time. The submitted abstracts will be reviewed and selected by a peer review committee. However, the duly constituted selection and review committees will have full authority to select or reject an abstract. Invitation for full length paper will only be sent for selected abstracts.

The full length original, empirical high quality research papers, are required to be submitted within stipulated time. Receiving of ppt files for presentation will be **appreciated three days before the date of presentation** by e-mail.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

- The seminar papers should be original, unpublished and adhere to the seminar theme.
- The maximum word limit for abstract along with keywords (the maximum number of keywords is 7) should not be more than 500.
- The word limit for full length paper should be 3000–5000.
- Papers must be typed in Times New Roman and sent as MSWORD files and (soft copy) by email only. (spsnsou@gmail.com)
- Place the title of your Paper on the left hand top corner (font size 14), the contributors' name (font size 12) in the next line, followed by your designation, Institutional affiliation, email ID and contact number (font size 11).
- The (running) text of the Paper must be written in font size 12, with 1.5-line spacing.
- Reference Style: APA 6th edition should be followed strictly.
- The entire content (endnotes and bibliography apart) are to be justified in indent.
- If you are using pictures or clips in your Paper, stick to the JPG format; tables if used must be centered and suitably aligned.
- Any data used in writing must be adequately substantiated and authenticated.
