Onset of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Swami Vivekananda Memorial Lecture: For the 2nd Swami Vivekananda Memorial Lecture titled 'Life-Blessed in Ethics and Values' Swami Jnanalokananda, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House & Cultural Centre, Kolkata was invited to deliver his speech. The speaker was introduced with all humility and grace before the audience. Swamiji deliberated upon the life and preaching of Swami Vivekananda in the realm of values and ethics enshrined in the lives of humans. Swami Vivekananda was a Hindu monk from India. His teachings and philosophy are a reinterpretation and synthesis of various strands of Hindu thought, most notably classical yoga and (Advaita) Vedanta, with western esotericism and Universalism. He blended religion with nationalism, and applied this reinterpretation to various aspects of education, faith, character building as well as social issues pertaining to India. Swamiji's one-hour lecture was divine, pious and glistening with human ethos and ethics. The captivating talk smouldered that according to Vivekananda, an important teaching he received from Ramakrishna was that Jiva is Shiva (each individual is divinity itself). So, he stressed on Shiva Jnane Jiva Seva, (to serve common people considering them as manifestation of God). According to Vivekananda, man is potentially Divine, so, service to man is indeed service to God. Swamiji distributed booklets and photo of Swami Vivekananda to one and all present.
