Center for Language, Translation and Cultural Studies (CLTCS), School of Humanities introduces two Short Term Course in Communicative English at the Kalyani Campus of NSOU, Ghoshpara, Kalyani, Nadia, for academic session 2018-2019.

Course Title: Certificate in Communicative English (CICE)

Objectives of the course: To train candidates in language skills. They will learn skills involved in survey taking, problem solving and negotiations. The candidates will be taught to use a number of communication strategies such as follow up questions and giving extended answers.

Mode of Delivery: F2F & Practical's (on Sunday and Wednesday)

Course Duration: 3months OR 12 weeks [July2019 to September2019]

Course Structure: 200 marks

Paper 1- Speaking and Listening Skills [30hrs]

Paper 2- Reading and Writing Skills [30hrs]

Evaluation Method: Evaluation will be made on the basis of internal assignment and practical examination held on the completion of the course. 20% marks are reserved for internal assignment of each paper. Pass marks is 40% in each paper.
