<u>Brief Report on One-Day National Conference on "Enhancing Teacher Education through OER" on 19th Nov 2015.</u>

This conference intended to bring out the significance of Open Educational Resources (OERs) in the realm, of Teacher Education, especially in an Open & Distance mode of Higher Education. NSOU being a premier State Open University grabbed the opportunity to conduct such a National Level Conference jointly with TESS-INDIA. The School of Education (SoE), NSOU conducted the programme on 19th Nov, 2015 in the Seminar Hall, NSOU Hgs, Salt Lake City, Kolkata with a view to instil the idea of OER& MOOC and its use in enhancing teacher education in particular.
