Prof. Swapan Kr Sarkar, the illustrious speaker was invited to deliberate upon the theme chosen to pay homage to Vidyasagar on his 202nd birth anniversary. Prof. Sarkar touched upon every single detail of Vidyasagar, right from his birth to his relentless contribution to the Indian society in the route of progress, upliftment and development. His enticing lecture kept everyone hooked.

Excerpts of the speech:

Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar was a great social worker and a scholar in Sanskrit who challenged the social trends of his time. Some of his great contribution to the society is banning child marriage, education rights for women and widow remarriage laws. Being a scholar in Sanskrit he also helped in the development of Bengali language. Due to his profound contribution to the scripts of Bengali language he is known to be one of India's greatest man. His ways of thinking and the ways of executing acts were very much ahead of his time. Even today, when a child starts to learn Bengali, the first book that is introduced to him is 'Barno Parichay', a landmark and hallmark contribution by Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar. This book carries information about Bangla characters. His effort in reviving knowledge to Bengal is an inspiring story in itself for the young generation.

Vidyasagar, the 19th-century educationist and a social reformer has much more significance in the 21st century. His battle against odds is our true guide.
