
- ♣ Gain confidence and skills to deliver academic content


Presentation 1:

Shantanu Saha, Research Scholar, Department of Education, NSOU gave his presentation on "Empowering School Education: Importance and Benefits of Action Research". In this presentation he first introduced the concept of Action Research with definitions by Kurt Lewin, Stephen M. Corey & S. Backwell. Then he discussed the steps in Action Research and showed the spiral model of Action Research. After that he discussed the benefits of Action Research for the teachers as well as students. Then Action Research with relation to several other concepts like student centered learning, collaborative learning, evidence-based decision making, community engagement etc. were discussed in this presentation.



Presentation 2:

Sardiya Sultana, Research Scholar, Department of Education, NSOU gave her presentation entitled "Significance of Research in Education". In her presentation she first introduced the concept of research as well as the concept of educational research. She then discussed the types of Research and the importance of statistics in research.
