



- 8. Diploma in Applied Art






Since the pandemic, the School has been conducting the term-end examination through digital platform successfully. The process/system of examination has been discussed in detail and it was decided that the theory paper (s) will be conducted through online (MCQ) to assess the domain knowledge of the students and the practical papers will be conducted on face to face mode to assess skills and competency in the specific trade by the respective study centres. The online examination (theory papers) will be conducted through LMS which is pass word protected and can be accesses only through personal user ID and password. The admit card may be collected by the students from their

respective Study Centre before the commencement of the examination.




NEW PAGE OPENS with course Structure


