Period of Online BDP Term End (Theory and Practical) Examinations  
December 2020 & June 2021

From 03.10.2021 (11:55pm) to 10.10.2021 (11:55pm)

Examinees concerned may appear at any time (within the above-mentioned time 'limit') as per their convenience.

The examinees concerned are requested to adhere to the following points: -

1. The examinees who have completed all pre-examination formalities for Online Examination (such as submission of filled-in Examination form, submission of Online Assignment, fees etc.) are eligible for this Online BDP Term End (Theory and Practical) Examinations December 2020 & June 2021.
2. For the said Online Examination, the examinees may get an 'Admit Card' from a dedicated portal ([www.nsoucebdp.com/](http://www.nsoucebdp.com/) [www.wbnsou.ac.in](http://www.wbnsou.ac.in)).
3. Examinees can appear in the said examinations through a Smartphone or Tab (Tablet PC), Laptop or Desktop Computer with active data connectivity. It may please be noted that the learners concerned can't login through more than one device at the same time.

4. For the said examinations another dedicated portal (<https://bdpjun21.nsou.smartestexam.com/>) has to be used. Examinees can login to this portal by entering Enrolment Number, Date of Birth and Roll Number (as printed on Admit Card and Enrolment Certificate cum Identity Card). At the time of login, the learners will get OTP to the given phone number or email address. Examinees are requested not to share any information which has been written in the Admit Card and Enrolment Certificate cum Identity Card.
5. The portal will be opened on 03.10.2021 at 11:55pm and will be closed on 10.10.2021 at 11:55pm (24 hours for Seven days).
6. The examinees concerned have to complete their all paper/s (as mentioned in the Admit Card) within the given limited time (24 hours for Seven days) from the commencement (on & from 03.10.2021 at 11:55pm) of the said examination.
7. Question Bank/Instruction Sheet of only Practical papers will be uploaded on 27.09.2021 at the official website of NSOU.
8. Examinees concerned may appear in any time (within the limited period), in any paper according to their choice, but they will get the scope to appear in another paper only after submission of the earlier paper.
9. MCQ method are being followed in the said Online Examinations.

10. The examinees have to answer the questions only putting a tick (✓) in the proper place.
11. The examinees will get Three Hours (if full marks is 100) and Two Hours (if full marks is 50) to complete a particular paper. After that time will be out for that paper.
12. In the said online examinations, for 100 marks, the examinees have to answer 20 questions (each of 1 mark) which is equivalent to full marks 100. Where the full marks are 50, the examinees have to answer 10 questions (each of 1 mark) which is equivalent to the full marks 50.
13. In the said online examinations all questions cannot be seen together, which means no examinee can't see all the questions at a time for a particular paper. At first only one question of a paper will be shown. The next question of the paper will appear only after submission of the answer of that question (The examinees have to submit the answer before going for the next question). The same procedure will be followed for the subsequent questions.
14. If examinees concerned cannot answer a question and want to avoid/skip that question, they may face the next question without answering it. In that case they have to 'submit' it without giving any answer and only after that they will get a new alternative question.

15. Once the answer has been submitted, it can no longer be corrected / edited and the examinees concerned will not be able to return to his previous position.
16. There will be no negative marking in the said Online Examinations.
17. Examinees will get 9 (nine) 'pause' for 100 marks and 4 (four) 'pause' for 50 marks for a particular paper. The duration of "pause" will not be counted in the original duration of a particular paper and the answer submitted by the learner at the previous time of "pause" will be saved as usual. It may please be noted that after any kind of interruption (pause), the learners can rejoin, but instead of the earlier question they will get a new question of the same paper. But after taking the scope of all pauses, time will be out. So the examination of the paper concerned will automatically locked after the pause limit is over. At the time of taking pause, examinees cannot refresh the device from which they are appearing the said examinations.
18. An examinee may save and download the paper/s only after 7 days from completion of entire examinations and they may get a print copy of paper/s. These printed copies are for personal preservation only as a challan. Examinees concerned are requested not to submit them anywhere.
19. EMT-16 has two parts, one part is Theoretical (30 marks) and another part is Practical (20 marks). For theoretical part of 30 marks of EMT-16, a paper consisting of 10 MCQs (each of 1 mark) with duration of 1 hour, which is equivalent to full marks 30. For Practical

part of 20 marks of EMT-16, the paper is consisting of 10 MCQs (each of 2 marks) with duration of 1 hour. Examinees will get 4 'pause' for 30 marks and another 4 'pause' for 20 marks.

20. For English old syllabus paper seven (EEG - 7) and paper eight (EEG - 8) examinations will be held with pen - paper mode. Question Paper Cum Answer Booklet have to be downloaded from the same portal. After that the examinees concerned have to write answers at the given space on these papers. After completion they have to scan the Question Paper Cum Answer Booklet and upload them to a dedicated mail address which will be written on the answer booklet. The duration of examination is of 2 hours and full marks are 20 which is equivalent to 100 marks.

21. Any unfair means, adopted during the examinations, detected by the e-surveillance system of the university, will be dealt with as per decision of the university taken on case to case basis.
