


- a) Analyse the relationship between curriculum development and syllabus design with reference to English Language Teaching.








- c) Discuss the contribution of Harold Palmer and Michael West in syllabus design.


 What is the relevance of their contribution in the globalised scenario today?

 - f) Prepare a Session Plan of at least 60 minutes that might reflect an integral part of the syllabus that you have designed in this context.




