- The term end examination procedures



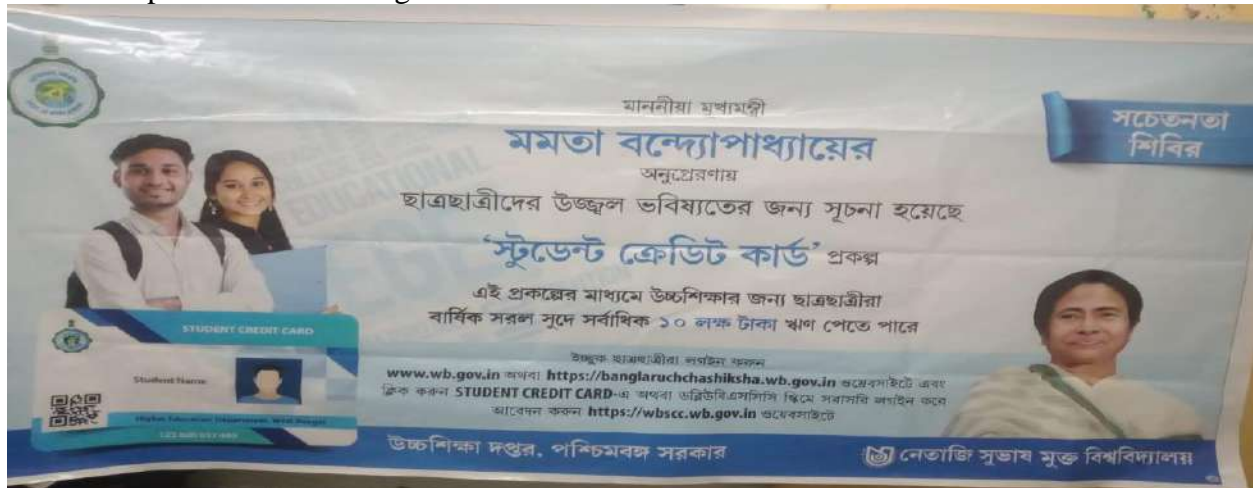
Address by Prof (Dr.) Ashit Baran Aich:

Address by Sri Madhurya May Das, Assistant registrar, Study Centres:
