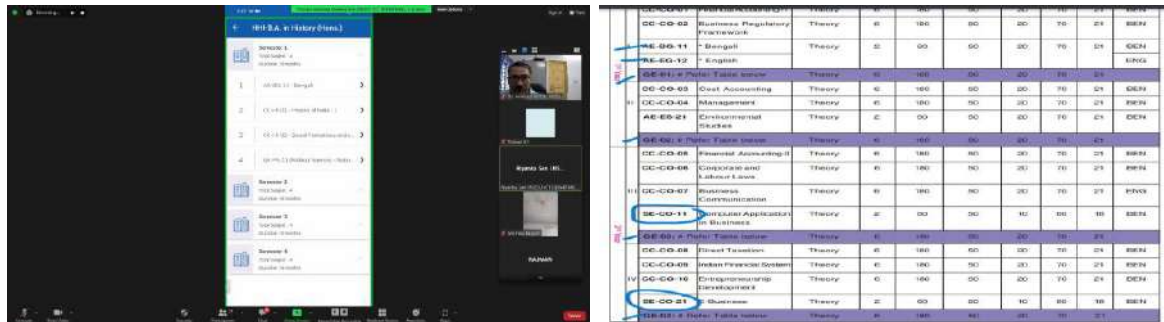
Professor Anirban Ghosh welcomed all the participants to the virtual Pre-admission counselling for admission into 3-year UG Degree programme under CBCS. The university published the admission notification for admission into its undergraduate degree programme under CBCS for the academic session 2023-24. The Centre for Internal Quality Assurance organized the virtual awareness programme for the prospective learners of the University. About 20 students attended the programme. As per the notification, the students may take admission in 15 UG degree programmes under five schools of Studies. Dr. Ghosh in his lecture discussed that the students have the option at various levels in the online admission form. The students may select any one programme out of 15 programmes and then may select their nearest LSC available in the drop-down menu. The student has to select the courses from the GEC, AECC and SEC groups. The students were also informed that after admission, they cannot change the programme and courses selected by them.



Dr. Sudeshna Chatterjee, Jt. Registrar (Academic) described the entire admission process. She mentioned that there is no need to visit the Learner Support Centre at this stage. The verification of documents are carried out online from Hqtrs. There are three step processes of the online

admission system. After the successful submission of the admission form with supporting documents, students have to wait for confirmation. On receipt of confirmation, the students may deposit the requisite fees either through an online payment gateway or at the bank counter. The students were advised to keep the user ID and PW for subsequent logging into the portal. They were also told that the students may give unique mobile numbers as they use and keep them active till they finish their studies at NSOU.

Shri Prosenjit Bhattacharya demonstrated the social media channel which is being used by the university especially through facebook. The university has opened an official facebook for online publicity of its activities including the admission.



The service provider demonstrated various ICT-based support system of the university viz. digitized SLMs, web TV, web radio, LMS etc. The students may take advantage of mobile app to pursue their studies online.

During Q/A session, the students across the state put some questions on admission, acceptability of degree, dual degree, examination system, availability of previous year's etc. which were suitably addressed by the Director, CIQA.

The programme ended with formal vote of thanks proposed by the Director, CIQA.
