MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) FOR PROMOTION OF EDUCATION
FOR THE EMPOWERMENT OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Netaji Subhas Open University (hereinafter referred as 'NGOU') having its office at DD-26, Sector-i, Salt Lake City, Kelkata 700064 and the Rehabilitation Council of India, thereinafter referred to as 'RCI') a Statutory Body under the Ministry of Secial Justice & Empowerment, the market of Disability Affairs, having its of July 3-22, Quitab Institutional Area, New Belhi-110016 was signed on 8th Depember. 2004 for collaboration in promoting education through distance mode for empowerment or persons with disabilities.

In pursuance of the above MoU, Special Education courses namely B.Ed-Special Education through Distance Education (B.Ed.-SEDE) in the area of Mental Retardation, Hearing Impairment & Visual Impairment, Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education (PGPD) in the area of Mental Retardation, Hearing Impairment & Visual Impairment were successfully implemented with an encouraging acceptability and increasing demand.

The above said MoU was renewed and extended further on 03 February, 2010 for another five years w.e.f. 09th December, 2009 to conduct the special education courses as per the provisions of the MoU.

Based on the MoU as signed between NSOU & RCI on 03rd February, 2010 the present MoU is signed on 24th April, 2015 at Kolkata by the Registrar on behalf of NSOU and by the Member Secretary on behalf of RCI and both the parties agreed to extend the MoU for another five years w.e.f 08th December, 2014 and abide by the provisions therein to achieve the desired goals.

The present MoU is an extension of the NirU signed between NSOU & RCI on 13.3rd. February, 2010 for collaboration in promoting education for empowerment of persons with disabilities and is governed by the following provisions:

- The NSCU will collaborate with RCI in designing programme and development of multimedia for Special Education courses through Open & Distance Learning (ODL) and will facilitate delivery and certification courses.
- RCI accepts NSOU as State Open University equipped for undertaking Special Education courses through Open & Distance Learning (ODL) in Bengali & English medium. RCI will also extend technical expertise to NSOU and its Study Centres as and when required.
- 3. NSOU in collaboration with RCI will conduct the following courses through Open & Distance Learning (ODL) mode in the State of West Bengal in Bengali and English Medium till the validity of MoU. Course wise allocations of seats to University & Study Centres are as under:

- Programmes marked (*) shall be launched on subject to development of Study Learning Material (SLM) by NSOU, vetted by experts appointed by RCI in the light of syllabi developed by RCI.
- II. SLM for the FCECLD-ODL shall be provided by the RCI
- III. B.Ed. Spl. Ec. (Disability & Inclusive Education) –ODL mode is to be implemented as per the latest norms and guidelines of RCI from the academic session 2015-16. Accordingly, SLM shall be developed by the NSOU in light of the revised syllabus...
- 4. For aforesaid courses, the faculty and infrastructural facilities at the University, academic contents, eligibility conditions, and process of evaluation etc. will be as prescribed by the RCI.
- 5. All the Special Education courses under operation or to be operated in future need to be planned as Transparent and on Self-Financing and Self-Sustaining Scheme with generation of funds through course fees and other charges to meet the running cost of the course.
- The amount of the Programme Fee and other charges is to be fixed in consultation with RCI to meet the financial implications for self-financing. No other fee or any other amount shall be charged by NSOU from the students.
- 7. On the basis of the criteria mentioned at Clause (5), course fees will be shared by the NSOU, RCI and the Study Centre(s) on PRORATA basis as per the norms fixed for each course as per need. The norm of sharing of course fees and other charges shall be fixed on a long-term perspective as per the following proportions:-
 - (a) NSOU: 50% of the total fee and charges collected in respect of special education courses and other courses as mentioned at Clause (3).
 - (b) Study Centre: 40% of the total fee and charges collected in respect of special education courses and other courses as mentioned at Clause (3).
 - (c) RCI: 10% of the total fee and charges collected in respect of special education courses and other courses as mentioned at Clause (3).
- Study Materials in respect of aforesaid courses will be supplied by NSOU to the Study Centres and students as per the requirement.

- Training institutes already running the teacher training courses approved by 9. the Council in the State of West Bengal may only be considered as a Study Centre(s) provided they meet the norms, for which NSOU will provide the list of prospective Study Centre(s) to RCI for issuance of NOC by RCI to prospective training institutes to act as a Study Centre under NSOU. The NSOU shall issue letter of approval to the concerned Study Centre(s) as per their rules and regulations. No other institute who are not running RCI approved courses shall be eligible to become Study Centre. If the approval granted to any Study Centre is withdrawn by the RCI after issuance of NOC then the affliation of that Study Centre by the NSOU will automatically stand cancelled 'However, the students already enrolled in the Study Centre concerned will be allowed to continue the course within the time frame as stipulated under Clause -3.
- NSOU and RCI will jointly decide the norms in respect of the honorarium to 10. the faculty and detailed process of admission, examination and evaluation etc.
- The passing Certificate and Degree shall be awarded by NSOU to the 11. students. However, Authentication Certificate required for registration with the RCI shall be issued by the concerned approved Study Centre(s) from where the candidate has completed the course.
- Any dispute between NSOU and the concerned study centre shall be 12. resolved by them without any involvement of RCI.
- There will be an Apex Advisory Committee (AAC) which will normally meet 13. twice a year, to oversee the implementation of the MoU. The composition of AAC shall be as under:
