According to the Global Report 2023 from the Internal Displacement Monitoring Centre, the number of people internally displaced due to disasters was a record-breaking 32.6% in 2022. Over 216 million people might become internal climate migrants by 2050, according to the World Bank, unless rapid and coordinated climate and development action is taken.
