The meeting was chaired by Prof.Kajal De. At the outset, she welcomed all the members present.

The following transactions/resolutions/deliberations were taken by the members unanimously:

- 1. The proceedings of the last BOS meeting held on 10.01.2018 was read and confirmed.
- 2. It was reported that as per earlier resolutions, the revision of existing EBT and SBT syllabi under BDP has been made following the UGC CBCS syllabi by experts as approved by the Vice Chancellor. Based on such revision of syllabi, the entire EBT courses were distributed to 14 compulsory core courses as per UGC pattern including three (marks 100 each) practical courses (EBT I to EBT 14).

Accordingly, the EBT and SBT courses were allotted to some approved writers for writing, rewriting, addition, alteration, modification and editing the SLMs (Self learning materials, i.e. Study Materials) in Bengali following the revised syllabi. Most of the study materials have been completed by the concerned authors. After due editing each SLM was sent to press for printing. Proof corrections have already been done for some SLMs.

In the meantime, NSOU as per directives of competent authority has formulated a uniform structure of syllabus for all subjects for implementation of UGC syllabus under CBCS. Since most of the SLMs of Botany are ready in Bengali, the NSOU authority has decided to propare the rest of the SLMs of Botany in Bengali which may be converted to English in due course.

 The NSOU authority as a policy matter intends to introduce UGC-CBCS under Semester system w.e.f. July 2020 session. Considering this issue the University authority has introduced a

uniform pattern of teaching-learning system keeping parity with conducting examinations in different subjects.

The syllabus for BDP chemistry was discussed in details and after threadbare deliberation it was finalized as attached Annexure-I.
- The meeting endorsed the necessity to increase the contact hour for laboratory practical to complete
 the course content of newly proposed syllabus for CBCS system.
