ADMISSION FEES:

Candidates are required to bring with them a Bank Draft of Rs. 16,330/- (Rupees Sixty Thousands Three Hundred Thirty only) in favour of "Netaji Subhas Open University" payable at **Kolkata** to attend counselling process.

Note:

- **Draft will be received only after verification of candidature and also subject to the availability of seats. In the event of non-availability of seat, the drafts will not be accepted and the candidates are to cancel their drafts at their own cost.**
- **Failure to produce Demand Draft correct in all respect will automatically cancel the candidature.**



DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED:

At the time of counselling candidates should report with the following documents:

1. All original Mark sheets, Certificates, Proof for Date of Birth, Cast Certificate (For other than General Category), PWD Certificate and Identity Card (For PH Candidates) are to be produced at the time of Counselling.
2. Self attested Photocopies of all testimonials.
3. Two recent passport size colour photographs
4. Print out of the Online Application Form
5. Study Centre's Copy of the Bank Challan (Paid During Online Admission Process)

Failure to produce all the documents stated above may result in cancellation of the candidature.

GENERAL GUIDELINE:

1. Reservation of seats for SC/ST/PH/OBC-A/OBC-B is applicable to candidates of West Bengal only. SC/ST/PH/ OBC-A/OBC-B candidates of other states cannot avail of this facility.
2. The candidates earmarked under any slot of the counselling programme must report at the time stipulated for him/her in the merit list. The counselling will not be stopped for any particular candidate being absent at the time of reporting of that particular slot.
3. A candidate missing his/her own slot will in no case be accommodated in any subsequent slot.
4. A candidate must appear in person at the counselling venue for allotment of seat.
5. Counselling as per the declared schedule shall continue till availability of seats. The counselling of a particular category will be stopped instantly as soon as all seats in that category are filled up. No further queries in this regard will be entertained.
6. Any discrepancy/ anomaly noted in the merit list may be brought to the notice of the University within **14th September 2015 (till 3.00 PM)** by email (nsou@wbnsou.ac.in) only.
7. No TA/ DA will be paid by the NSOU for attending the Counselling.
