grasp theoretical understanding of the concepts and philosophies as well as practicum to gain proficiency to deliver in real situations. The curricular basket is dove tailed to make it compendious and poised. The NEP 2020 has rightly emphasized integrating inclusive education in the system of education and the nation is also heading to make India an Inclusive country. Therefore, the mission must be exercised and disseminated to the clientele through programs smitten with such tenets.
