The fourth ELT Special Lecture on “Critical Pedagogy” was organised by the Department of English Language Teaching on 5th December 2023 from 8.00-9.00 pm. The Speaker for the lecture was Professor S Mohanraj, Professor ELT, NSOU. The talk began with a formal introduction to pedagogy and covered the innovations in pedagogy over the decades and innovation in teacher education.
