About the Workshop:

The project 'Women Learners in History Programmes: A Case Study of NSOU' has been undertaken by Dr Ritu Mathur Mitra, Principal investigator and Head & Associate Professor, Dept. of History, School of Social Sciences. Based on primary enrolment data of NSOU, the project is focussed on determining and understanding the socioeconomic profile of UG and PG women learners in History programmmes in NSOU. This includes analysing the career perspective of History students and to understand the issues that comes in their way of getting higher education and successful careers. The duly approved project had also proposed a workshop for the History women learners of NSOU, interested in career prospects. In this context, Dr. Mathur Mitra approached the Confederation of Indian Industry (Head Office: Gurgaon, Kolkata Branch Office: Salt Lake) to organize a workshop.

➤ In his Introductory speech, Prof. Anirban Ghosh, Director CIQA, NSOU stressed the importance of women's career and different methods undertaken by distance education especially NSOU to promote skill sets for life long and sustainable learning projected at promoting employability and successful careers for NSOU Leaners. He outlined the various courses being conducted by NSOU especially aimed at creating career-women.

- h. Professional behaviour, discipline at workplace and work readiness counselling






1. Q & A Session- The students asked several questions related to career and how to be on the right track.


After the completion of the workshop, the students were given a feedback form and after submission certificates of participation were also prepared for the students







Count of What future career would you prefer?




Count of How was the venue and facilities at NSOU?




Count of Was the trainer from CII-MCC helpful?




Count of To what extent did the workshop create a valuable impression?
