 - d) What is meant by tenancy reform ?
 - e) Briefly explain the Laissez Faire policy.
 - f) Mention two distinguishing features of a peasant economy.

- a) Write a note on the system of Collective Farms in Russia.
 - b) Briefly mention the difficulties of measuring different contributions of agriculture to non-agriculture sectors.
 - c) Discuss the situation of Scylla and Charybdis in Lewis model.
 - d) Discuss the problems of sub-division and fragmentation of agricultural land holdings in India.
 - e) Briefly explain the Prebisch-Singer thesis and its implication.
 - f) Briefly describe the main features of a peasant economy.

- a) Discuss the complementary relation between Agricultural revolution and Industrial revolution in Great Britain.
- b) Derive the balanced growth path between agriculture and industry in the Ranis-Fei model.
- c) Do you think that land reform is a condition for economic development ? Judge from the historical aspects of land reform.
- d) Discuss different types of peasants and their adoption of suitable technology.

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
