The examination form is available on www.wbnsou.ac.in.
 - Examination fee is Rs. 75/-(seventy-five only) per theory paper only,i.e.Paper-I,II,III,IV & VI.
 - Examination fee is Rs.100/-(one hundred only) for paper-V: practical workshop: 50 marks per candidate.
 - Examination fee is Rs.100 (one hundred only) for Paper V-practical writing: 50 marks per candidate.
 - Examination Centre Fees per candidate for Theory Examination – Rs.100/-.
 - Examination Centre Fees per candidate for Practical Workshop Examination - Rs 100/-.
 - Assignment Evaluation fee is Rs.30/- (thirty only) per theory paper: 100 marks (i.e.Paper-I, II, III, IV & VI) and Rs20/-(twenty only) for paper-V practical assignment writing: 50 marks.
 - Submission of Assignment is the pre-condition for appearing in PGDJMC & ADJMC Term End Examination December 2022.
