Paper XA Broadcast Journalism (Field-Based)- 50 Marks

Paper XA (Broadcast Journalism) of the PGJM program, the course is structured into two parts, with each part contributing 25 marks.

Group-based Audio/ Audio Visual Components:

Learners' Groups:

Learners are divided into micro groups to manage the remaining field-based practical components.

Component Details:

Group A: 1. Audio- Compelling Audio Interview with a substantive personality (up to 10-15 minutes).

2. Audio Story/Audio Documentary, Audio commentary (min 10 minutes)

Group B: Audio-Visual-

1. TV Documentary (up to 10 minutes)

2. PTC (Piece to Camera) (up to 120 seconds) on any relevant themes.

Submission Mode:

All group activities must be submitted via pen drive. Examinees should clearly label each file according to the relevant components, mentioning both the group name and each participant's role. Each group must submit two pen drives—one to be retained by the department and the other for the examination department.

These documents will be retained as a permanent record by the NSOU.
