NOTICE

Students are hereby notified that School of Sciences, Netaji Subhas Open University is going to arrange the annual Laboratory Counseling-cum-Evaluation Session, 2023 (LCES, 2023) in two phases namely Phase-1 (October 30, 2023 – November 10, 2023) & Phase-2 (December 24, 2023 – February 25, 2024) for its Undergraduate science students in their respective papers. Detailed schedule of two phases LCES are given below.

Phase-1 of LCES-2023 will be held of **twelve days'** duration at a stretch during **October 30, 2023 – November 10, 2023 from 9 A.M to 5 P.M.** This phase of LCES, 2023 will be held for the **E-4, E-8, E-12 &** *EMT -16* (for Old BDP students in the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Geography & *Mathematics*) and **CC-01, CC-05, CC-11** (for CBCS Honours students in the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Geography) like previous years. During LCES programme first eleven days will be allotted for counseling and the final evaluation will be held on the 12th day. It may be noted that attendance and performance in first nine or eleven days also carry marks to their final mark sheet.

Saturdays & Sundays during the period of December 24, 2023 – February 25, 2024 from
9 A.M to 5 P.M. This phase of LCES-2023 will be held for the Subsidiary paper (S-3) in
the subjects Botany, Physics, Zoology (for Old BDP students) and CC-02, CC-06, DSE-02
& CC-MT-06 (for CBCS Honours students in the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Botany,



Zoology, Geography, Mathematics). The detailed allotment for phase-2 will be published later in a separate notice.
