- Academic Coordinators of all the concerned study centres are requested to send a signed monthly report of the PCPs (which must contain Date, Name of the PGGR paper, Name & Designation of the academic counsellors taken the PCPs, Number of students attended) following this routine.
- The students are advised to follow this master routine, frequently visit the university website for any update and consult the academic coordinators of their respective study centres for the PCP Classes.
- The students are advised to prepare the laboratory notebook of the PGGR practical papers as instructed during the PCPs. A copy of the laboratory notebook of each practical papers (whether the PCPs held in the university campus or in the study centres) need to submit by all the PGGR students jointly of each study centres (students of each study centre will submit one notebook for each practical papers, like 4B, 5A, 5B) to the concerned faculty-in-charge of NSOU.
- The internal faculties of NSOU will continue to conduct the online classes as an additional support, tutorials etc. along with the offline classes as and when applicable.
- This scheduled routine if need to adjust due to circumstantial obligations including electoral process, that may be initiated by the Academic coordinators of the S.C. with a prior information to the concerned Director/Officer-in-Charge and Departmental Heads/In charge.
