5. Students are advised to attend all the PCP classes in their respective study centre and University campus as and when notified. They are advised to consult the Academic Coordinators of their study centres for PCP classes and PGGR Self Learning materials.
6. The students are advised to prepare the Laboratory notebook of the PGGR practical papers as instructed during the PCP's. A copy of the notebook of each practical paper must be submitted jointly by the students (a photocopy) to the concerned faculty – in-charge of NSOU by each study centre.
